ABOUT THE SCHOOL

WHAT DEBBIE HAS TO SAY

Debbie lives in Cape Town and works full time as a fashion make-up artist working on photo shoots.

Debbie says: 'Make-up is my passion and passing on my knowledge through teaching the latest make-up techniques brings me great pleasure. I run a boutique school catering for those who have specific make-up needs.

My courses mainly focus on fashion and bridal make-up. I keep my classes small and my teaching techniques are detailed and concise. Video clips and reading material is supplied to each student.

Models are required to practice the techniques (friends and family - I do assist with this if totally necessary)

I make suggestions with regard to designing students make-up kit for their specific needs. I have hundreds of products for students to test and work with (All of which make-up artists get a discount on when purchasing).

I am not an agent and therefore don't find work for students after the course. I do however assist students to get on set (film shoots, photo shoots) when necessary and only when students show potential.

Each student gets guidance and support throughout the course. I teach most of my own lessons – class times might be changed due to my photo shoot schedule, but not without each student's go ahead. I do have assistant teachers when a date can't be moved.

My academy tends to cater for dynamic, self-sufficient people who want to train in depth in a reasonable time frame.

COURSES AVAILABLE

(2011 Set course dates are now finished, so courses during 2011 will be hosted if there is a demand. Please contact Debbie if you would like training in 2011.)

• 2, 4 and 8 Day Courses • Part Time Courses
(Full Time available on demand – day time classes 9am till 13:30)

Cost: 2 days: R 1800.00 4 day: R 2800.00 8 day: R 4700.00
Part time: R 7000.00 (60 Hours) Full Time: R 9500.00 (120 Hours)

Private lessons cost R1500 p/d or R1000 p/d if 2 people.

All listed courses are offered in Cape Town depending on the demand (in Sea Point). Debbie also travels to Gauteng to teach. At present 2, 4 and 8 Day Courses are offered in Gauteng (in Centurion)

Certificates are provided to each participant on the courses.
Part Time students can receive a certificate or they can do a practical exam and if the grade is reached a diploma will be earned.

THE 2 & 4 DAY COURSE:

These courses are designed for people who would like a hands on, up-to-date, short make-up course.

The courses are especially popular with people already involved in the beauty, fashion or hair industry, as it is an inspiring up to the minute refresher. It is also popular for applicants who would like an over all introduction to the art of make-up.

The syllabus is the same for the 2 and 4 Day Courses – 4 Day Course students obviously get an extra 2 days to master the techniques.

THE SYLLABUS:

- Professional products, tools and hygiene
- Designing your make-up kit
- Fashion photographic make-up techniques – including smokey eyes and creative applications
- Blending techniques – using brushes, fingers and sponges
- Eyebrow shaping and pencil art
- Creating illusion with make-up

- Day and evening applications – suitable for bridal, special occasion, shoots
- False lashes – individual/full set, using liquid liner and unique professional products: Primers, shadow magnets etc

8 DAY COURSE:

Students who do have the time and would like to take their skill to another level can sign up for the 8 Day Course.

More in depth training is provided on this course. Period make-up - 1920s to 1990s and fashion make-up (current looks) are covered in detail.

Students can request areas they would like to focus on during these classes. Speed tests also take place to ensure the application is not only quick enough, but also applied to a high standard.



Models are also required on the 8 day course.

8 day courses take place when there is demand for this course.

Please note – Debbie travels to Centurion to teach 2,4 and 8 Day Courses.

To cover the additional travel costs 6 students are required. If there is less than 6 students the course will be cancelled or if students are in agreement another qualified artist will be put in place to teach the course.

During 2012 Debbie will be in Gauteng during March, May and October based on the demand. Those students who would like to partake for just 2 days attend the first 2 days of the course. Those who would like to do the 4 Day Course attend the first 4 days of the course. If there are enough students who book for the 8 Days Course the last 4 days of the course will continue to make up a full 8 days.

Debbie will inform you how the bookings are going.

MODEL TIMES

2 DAY COURSE

Class starts at **9am sharp** and ends around 17:00

- **Day 1:** Model needed: approx. 16yrs – 30 yrs old. 11:30am – 13:30 and the same model or another model from 14:30 – 16:30.
- **Day 2:** Models needed for 1st two sessions also approx. 16yrs – 30yrs old. Last model of day needs to be a mature model (over 50 years if possible) 11:30am – 13:30 and the same model or another model from 14:30 – 16:30

4 DAY COURSE

Class starts at **9am sharp** and ends around 17:00

- **Day 1:** Model needed: approx: 16yrs – 30 yrs old from 11:30 – 13:30 and the same model or another from 14:30 until – 16:30
- **Day 2:** Models needed: approx. 16yrs – 30 yrs old from 11:30 – 13:30 mature model approx: 45/50 yrs and up from 14:30 until 16:30
- **Day 3:** Models needed: approx. 16yrs – 30 yrs old from 11:30 – 13:30 and again the same model or another model from 14:30 -16:30
- **Day 4:** Model needed: you decide - what ever you feel like practicing: bridal, day or evening make-up, mature skin or fashion. Times are the same as day 3

Debbie offers assistance with models when necessary, but at no guarantee.

8 DAY COURSE

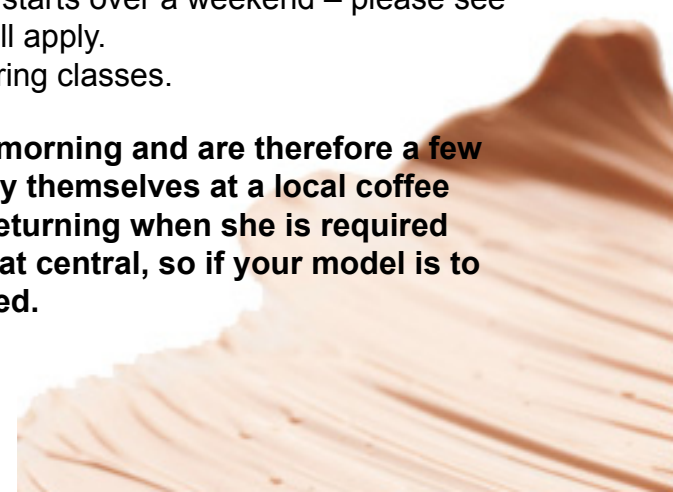
Please see model times Day 1 to 4 of the 4 Day Course as these times above also apply to the 8 Day Course students. During the first 4 days, model times will be arranged for day 5 to 8 of the course. Students may need to work on one another if models can't be arranged for a full 8 days.

PART TIME COURSE

Models will be needed for day 1 and 2 if your course starts over a weekend – please see models times for the 2 Day Course as these times will apply.

For the other lessons, model times are discussed during classes.

If your model/s needs to get a lift with you in the morning and are therefore a few hours early. Please note – all models must occupy themselves at a local coffee shop or something whilst teaching takes place, returning when she is required to model for you. In Centurion, classes are not that central, so if your model is to young to drive, she can wait at the studio if needed.



WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO BRING TO CLASS

(all classes apply)

- For your own use: hand towel, face cloth (compulsory) cleanser, make-up remover (Like Silk has a great make-up remover, it's pink in liquid form, inexpensive and non oily) cottonwool and moisturiser
- Pen and notebook A4 size
- Refreshments and snacks
- Your brush kit and sponges (You can purchase these items in class)

Brush kits cost: R 430.00 at student rate (18 piece brush kit in a pouch) and a sea sponge: R 40.00 and Powder puff R 50.00.

Total: R 520.00 - please bring your money if you are going to buy these items. If you want to use Debbie's and not purchase your own kit let her know in advance. There are 2 sets in the school and are provided on a first come first serve basis.

WHAT DEBBIE WILL SUPPLY FOR ALL CLASSES:

Brush cleaner and latex sponges and all professional make-up products for use during classes

Tea and coffee – short breaks are given during class.

THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

TIP: BRING YOUR CAMERAS TO CLASS FOR BEFORE + AFTER PHOTOS

Students may need to practice on one another.

Students will be required to work on models (friends or family).



MAKE-UP KITS

Debbie does not include student kits in the courses. Debbie says: 'Students can use all my make-up during the courses. (My kit is valued at about R 30 000.00) This way students get to work with a wide variety of products and can decide which items will work best for their kit.

Each student has different kit requirements and it's therefore more suitable and practical to offer each student a kit that actually works for the type of make-up they decide to specialise in.

I introduce students to professional make-up brands – after the course students can go purchase items they would like at a make-up artists discount. Ex-students will need to show each make-up brand their certificate in order to qualify for the discount. (Between 10% - 30% for make-up artists) Mac needs to see your business cards, certificate and some images of your work to qualify for their discount.

Brands used: Mac, Bobbi Brown, PMU (www.pmu.co.za), Kryolan

- Please note: If you would like to work with your own brushes from word go, Debbie can offer you a set of brushes in a pouch (18 pieces) for R 430.00. If you would like to purchase some of the products used during class at your last lesson (at your student discount), Debbie will have items on hand for your convenience.
- Debbie's teaching techniques are thorough and detailed and she is on hand for every moment of the classes. Training is intensive and constructive. NO time is wasted during classes and students WILL walk away with the most current techniques and tricks. 'Debbie says 'No one should have to train in fashion and bridal make-up for many months. If your training is of a high standard and constructive, with practice you should be able to apply beautiful make-up'

HOW TO BOOK

To book the course and ensure you have a place: For the 2, 4 and 8 Day Courses please pay a 50% deposit to secure your booking. The balance to be paid at the start of the first lesson or before the course starts via EFT.

Part Time Course 3 or less installments can be paid: Deposit before the course starts R 2333.33, at the first lesson: R 2333,33 and final payment half way through the course: R 2333,33 Totals: R 7000.00

The only extra cost is the brush kit and sponges: R 520.00

If you would like to purchase make-up after the course Debbie does have PMU in stock (www.pmu.co.za). Mac, Bobbi Brown and some other professional items need to be purchase in store.

If you want to book an extra day that is not on the course schedule to cover additional subjects you want to focus on - the cost is R 1500.00 per day. If there are 2 students it will cost R 1000.00 per day to book private time.

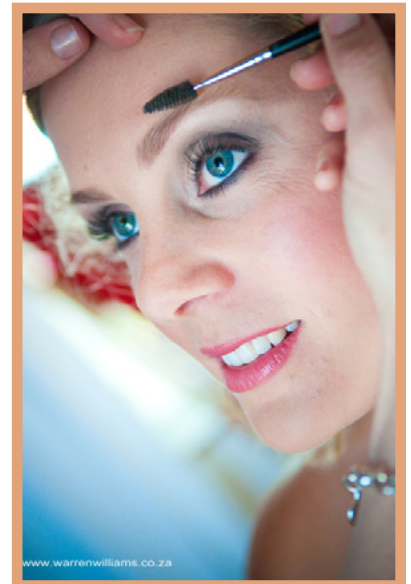
